Ex. SDG Gender Index is developed by Equal Measures 2030, a joint effort of regional and global organisations including African Women's Development and Communication Network, Asian-Pacific Resource and Research Centre for Women, Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation, etc. It accounts for 14 out of 17 SDGs (sustainable development goals) that cover aspects such as poverty, health, education, literacy, political representation and equality at the workplace. India is ranked 95th among 129 countries in 2019 SDG Gender Index.

Ex. Project SURE was launched by Union Textiles Ministry. SURE stands for 'Sustainable Resolution' - a firm commitment from the industry to move towards fashion that contributes to a clean environment. It will be the first holistic effort by the apparel industry towards gradually introducing a broader framework for establishing critical sustainability goals for the industry. This framework would help the industry reduce its carbon emissions, increase resource efficiency, tackle waste and water management, and create positive social impact to achieve long-term sustainability targets.

v. To establish Central Consumer Protection Authority for faster redressal of consumer complaints with respect to deficiency of goods or services or adulteration.
