Ex. The Indira Gandhi Government started the process of nationalisation of coal mines in the year 1971. The nationalisation was complete in the year of 1973, with the enactment of Coal Mines (Nationalisation) Act, 1973.  
This Act was repealed by the Narendra Modi Government in 2018, which allowed the private firms to enter commercial mining industry. Now coal allocation is done on the basis of bidding process. India imports coal to meet its domestic energy demands and it has not yet become self-sufficient in production of coal.
