- 1 C
Ex. • National lake conservation plan(NLCP) is implemented by the ministry of environment and forests since 2001.
• NLCD - objective.
It is to restore and conserve the urban and semi- urban lakes. And it is to conserve wetland also.
Ministry of environment and forest has not adopted a clear distinction between lakes and wetland. So statements 1 or 3 are incorrect and statements 2 is correct.

Ex. Core inflation is less volatile as compared to Headline Inflation.
RBI tracks CPI headline for monetary policy.
- 3 B
Ex. The 1896 Congress session was held at Calcutta under the presidency of Rahimtullah Sayani. In this session, Vande Mataram was sung for the first time by Rabindranath Tagore. The 1899 Congress session was held at Lucknow under the presidency of R.C Dutt. In this session noted critique of British economic policies, R.C Dutt urged the British government for permanent fixation of land revenue. The last session of Congress before independence was held in 1946 at Meerut. It was held under the presidency of J.B. Kripalani.

Ex. • Nekton : The group contains animals which are swimmers.
• The animals range in size from the swimming insets (about 2 mm long) to the largest animals. The blue whale sharks etc. so statements 1 or 3 are correct. Blue jellyfish is a plankton species 2 is not correct.
- 5 C
Ex. Three important contributors to this problem include Covid-19 Lockdown, Demonetisation & stressed banking sector, GST Implementation and problems in Agriculture sector. The public goods are provided by government and the government needs tax revenues to supply them, and these depend upon national income. Then there is employment. A demand for labour exists only when there is a demand for goods. So growth is necessary if employment is to be assured.

Ex. Located in the drought-prone Marathwada region, the district of Beed presents a challenge for any insurance company. During the 2020 kharif season, tenders for implementation did not attract any bids. So, the state Agriculture Department decided to tweak the guidelines for the district. The state-run Indian Agricultural Insurance Company implemented the scheme. Under the new guidelines, the insurance company provided a cover of 110% of the premium collected, with caveats. If the compensation exceeded the cover provided, the state government would pay the bridge amount. If the compensation was less than the premium collected, the insurance company would keep 20% of the amount as handling charges and reimburse the rest to the state government.

Ex. Parliament generally meets in three sessions in a year. These are budget session, monsoon session & winter session. The Special session of Parliament may possible during National Emergency proclaimed under Article 352.

Ex. • Isotopes : atoms of the same element having same atomic number but different mass number are known as isotopes.
• Isobars : the atom of different elements which have same number but different atomic number are called isobars.
• Isotones : some numbers of neutrons but different atomic numbers.

Ex. Currency in Circulation includes notes in circulation, rupee coins and small coins with public and with banks.

Ex. The 7th Constitutional Amendment Act of 1956 promoted the appointment of the same person as a Governor for two or more states. It is related to the reorganisation of states.
- 11 B
Ex. Recently, the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY) unveiled the National Strategy for Additive Manufacturing Policy. The policy aims to increase India's share in global additive manufacturing to 5% within the next three years and add USD 1 billion to the gross domestic product. Further, it aims to develop 50 India specific technologies for material, machine and software, 100 new startups for additive manufacturing, 500 new products and train at least 1 lakh new skilled workers. The Policy postulate the tenets of 'Make in India' and 'Atmanirbhar Bharat Abhiyan' that advocate self-reliance through the technological transformation of the production paradigm.

Ex. Only 2 UTs (Delhi and Pondicherry) have representation in Rajya Sabha.

Ex. Disguised Unemployment is the type of a phenomenon wherein more people are employed than actually needed. This is why the marginal productivity of the workers is zero here.

Ex. A resolution was adopted by Parliament recommending that the provisions of Article 370 be made inoperative and that it be amended to state that all provisions of the Indian Constitution would apply to Jammu and Kashmir. On the basis of this resolution, the President issued a notification making Article 370 inoperative.
